



MAP – Measures of Student Progress September 8^{th OR} 9th and 15^{th OR} 16th

- 1. MAP is a computer-based adaptive test REQUIRED!
- 2. An MAP Computer Prep document will be emailed out on the 3rd for families to prepare computers for the test. No login information will be provided until testing day.
- 3. REQUIRED Sept. 7th MAP Information Session
- 4. Students <u>must not</u> get any help while taking the MAP test. Any outside help invalidates test results. I need REAL data to see your student growth. Please, please, please do not help your student.




Daily Plan ...

Check for overdue assignments every morning to help yourself stay on track.








Not Mastered Assignments...




Too many students may possibly skip the "Try It" sections of assessments. The lesson will mark it complete if students click to the end. HOWEVER, that does NOT mean that students are answering the questions within that section.





Learning Coaches – check THROUGH lessons EVERY DAY. Pleeeeeeeeese!



Unfortunately, there may be a "refresh rate" for some of you. This means, that if you are away from your student during their worktime, it may appear as though they have not yet completed all the parts but the system will need to refresh and sometimes this can take 24hours.

This makes it tricky to keep up with how your student is completing work.

It's best to be nearby for your student to show you their work before they move onto the following section or at their side as expected.

Extra Attempts

The OLS provides roughly three attempts per lesson. No extra attempts beyond these three will be provided. It is very important that students do their best on the FIRST attempt to master an assessment. DO NOT immediately retake the assessment, but instead, here are the steps to take if you do not master an assessment:

- 1. Complete the **ENTIRE** lesson/assignment on your Daily Plan.
- 2. Study & review the concepts.
- 3. Retake only when your LC gives you permission.

Let's talk about assessments . . .

Throughout the year, your student will be completing assessments in various forms: MAP, Interim(quarterly), unit & semester assessments, etc.

Assessments <u>do not provide</u> all that your student is capable of. Assessments are only a snapshot in time.

I need assessments to be authentic. I need to see your <u>student growth</u> and will be analyzing data all year to be able to do my best, to help your student do their best and learn the most they possibly can so they may continue to grow year after year.

Please, please do not help your student with assessments unless there is a learning plan in place for your child. It may be difficult to watch your child struggle, experience frustration, etc. However, I am a huge fan of allowing them to see their own gains, growth & improvements!

Classkick
