Flipgrid – These Friday Flipgrids will resume and can be found on your Daily Plan (now that SBA is finished). These have a short window of time for completion each week.

Freckle – This appears on the Daily Plan each Monday, however, please open it up **daily** to practice your multiplication facts. Students who memorize their multiplication facts earlier in the year, have a MUCH easier time with math for the remainder of fourth grade.

MAP Accelerator/Khan Academy – Working within this app is required each day for 10 minutes totaling 50 minutes per week. This is integrated as a collaboration of the MAP Assessments with Khan Academy to provide adaptive practice for the skills each individual student needs. It's fabulous!

MOST students used their account last school year and know how to access MAP Accelerator and the “BLUE PATHWAY” to guide them. **SOME students** will need direction on how to log in and how to work within MAP Accelerator.

IF YOU ARE A NEW STUDENT NEEDING TO SET UP YOUR MAP ACCELERATOR, PLEASE FOLLOW THESE DIRECTIONS:

1. <https://www.khanacademy.org/join/57PRNTH4>
2. You will need to then select “create an account” or “sign up with your school email” depending on what options it gives you. When creating your account, please be sure to use your WAVA STUDENT ONLY email and create a password you will remember (I recommend using your WAVA account password). IF you are asked for the class code, it is **57PRNTH4**.
3. Once you have activated your account, I will set your placement and assign you topics to work on. Again, your goal is to spend at least 10 minutes a day working on this content. Please review the attached document that contains important information about using MAP Accelerator.
