## To Dos:

- 1. Secure Testing Browser please be sure this is downloaded onto your computer before the weekend begins. https://wa.portal.cambiumast.com/secure-browsers.html (Directions below)
- 2. Please use this link <a href="https://forms.office.com/r/68gHgMn10w">https://forms.office.com/r/68gHgMn10w</a> to confirm that you HAVE downloaded the Secure Testing. I need to verify that this task has been completed.
- 3. Calendar your site & times for testing.

#### Extra Info:

- The same parent that signs a student in, will sign them out unless arrangements are made at sign in with the Proctor that day.
- Students bring their own computer with the secure testing browser downloaded as well as their own headphones, if possible, which is usually more comfortable for students.
- Daily Plan I will work to whittle down lessons during this two-week window. Each student in our class tests on different days, therefore blocking off specific days doesn't work from my end. Students MAY have some overdues appear if they were out testing on a day and couldn't complete all lessons on the Plan. IF THIS HAPPENS don't worry. You will not be scored down, but instead, try to complete those as soon as possible.
- Class Connects As some of you, students are required to make weekly contact each week. This will most likely happen next week in our Monday Meeting on the 11th. # Student View...Timeline of a typical testing session

- · You will arrive at your testing site at the sign in time listed on your test ticket email. You don't arrive early because you know your TA is working with other students or setting up the site before your check in time.
  - o If you are in Grades 3-8, your authorized adult must sign you in. If you are in Grades 9-12 and have your own picture ID, you can sign yourself in, or have your authorized adult come with you
- You and your authorized adult see WAVA staff at the entrance of the testing site. There is a WAVA Staff Member checking to make sure you don't feel sick and reminding you of the health and safety

  • Do your best to answer the questions to the best of your ability and try not to stress about questions requirements. They ask you what group you are in which is printed on your test ticket email. They direct you to the TA of your group for check in
- You meet your Test Administrator (TA) and your authorized adult signs you in on the paper attendance roster. You give any electronic devices you have (cell phone, watch, Fitbit, etc.) to your authorized adult to hold for you during your test.
- Once all the other students in your group arrive (will be 15 or less), you say goodbye to your authorized adult and follow your TA into the testing area to set up.
- . First thing to do is wash your hands. If restroom facilities are not convenient, your TA will provide you with a sanitizing wipe so you can disinfect your hands and/or your table area.
- · Your TA will help you find your seat and set up your computer. If you brought a purse or a bag, the TA will show you where you can place it (out of reach) while you test. If you couldn't bring the laptop you were practicing with from home, the TA will loan you one.

# Student View...Timeline of a typical testing session

- When your group is all setup and ready to go, your TA will read the instructions and help you login to your test. Your login information will be on your Test Ticket email. If you don't have that, your TA will look you up in their computer and help you login.
- The Fall 2021 tests are shorter than usual, and still untimed. You don't have to rush:
  - o ELA takes less than 75 minutes
  - o Math takes less than 60 minutes
  - Science takes less than 45 minutes
- that are unfamiliar. We KNOW there are questions on the test that you might not know the answers to. If you get stuck, just give your best guess and move on. You got this!
- . The TA will walk around the room to make sure everyone is doing OK and doesn't need any redirection or support. If you need something, raise your hand.
- . When you finish your test, submit it, then close your laptop and sit quietly and wait for the session to end. Other students might need more time, so don't distract them! Everyone works at their own pace and that's OK!
- . If you don't finish by the end of the session, that's OK too. The TA will talk to your authorized adult to see if you can stay with the next testing session for a little more time.
- When the session ends, pack up your belongings and go with your TA back to the entrance of the test site to sign out with your authorized adult. Once you are signed out, take a break and be proud of yourself! Go home and take a break!
