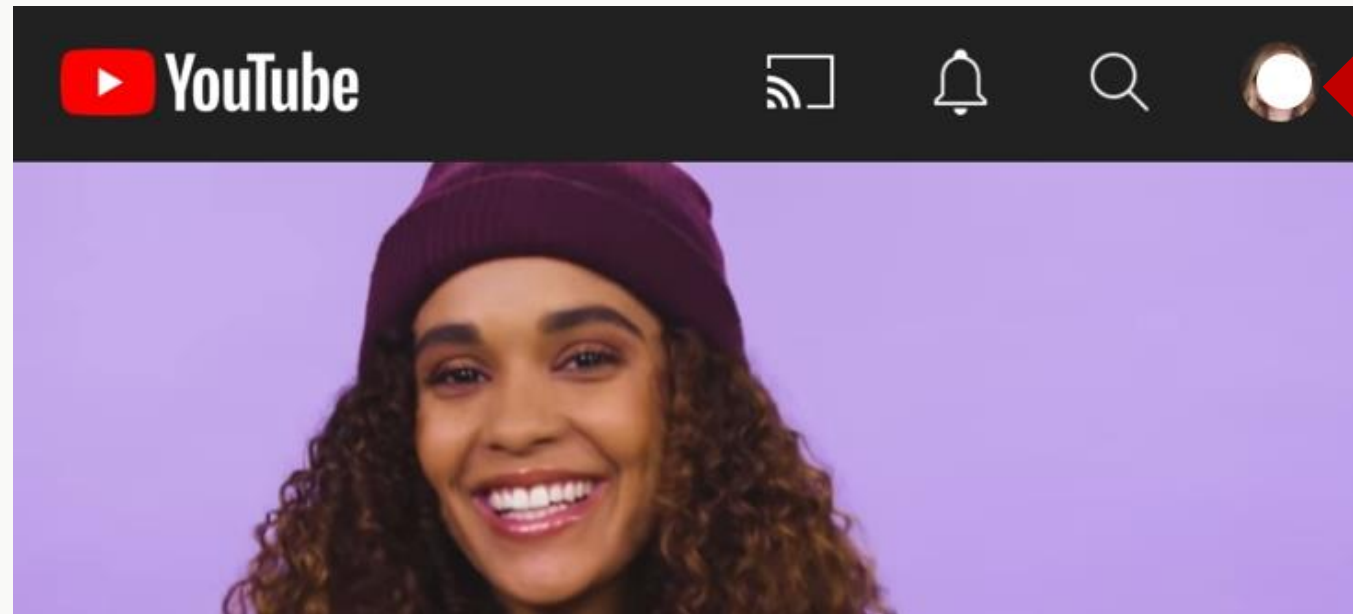
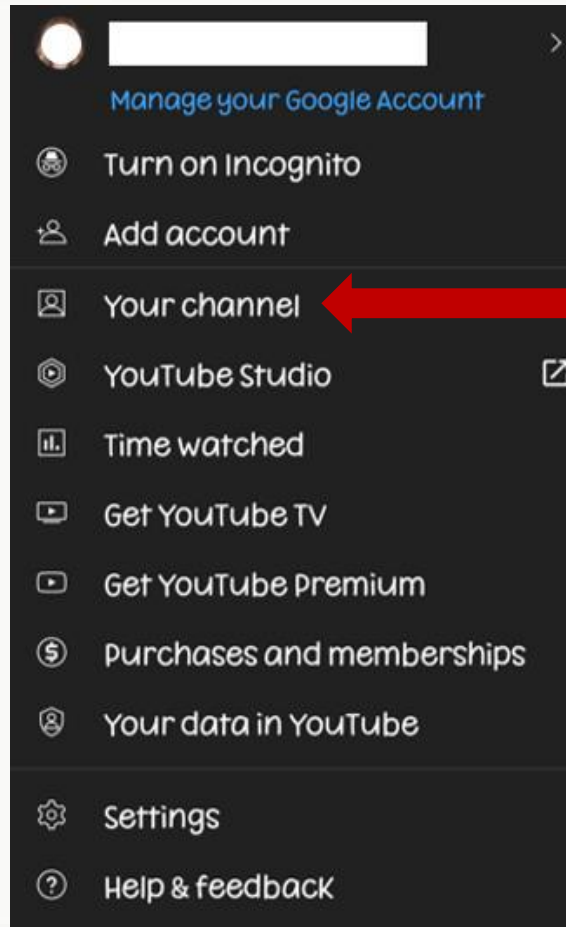




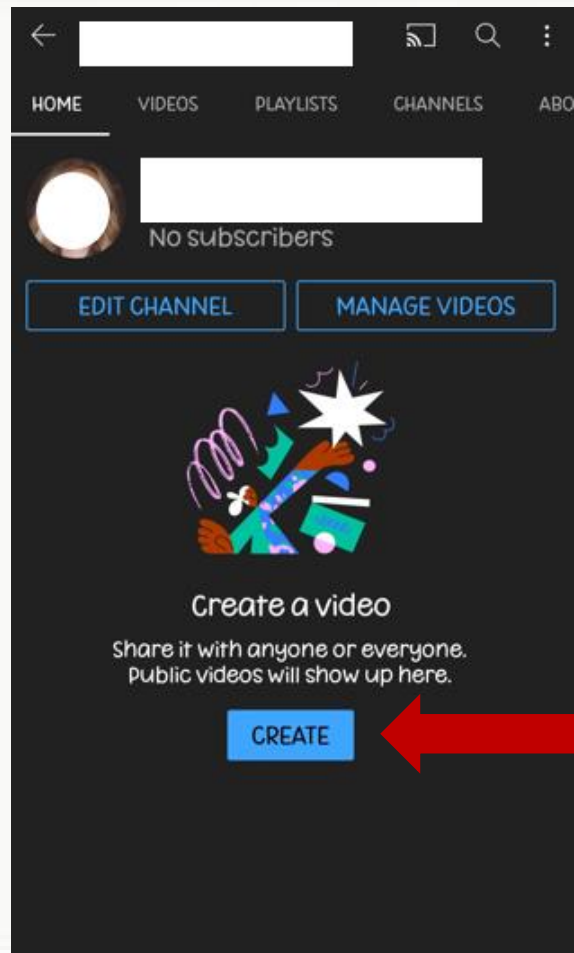
**How to upload an

First, log in to your YouTube account, and click your profile icon in the upper right corner:

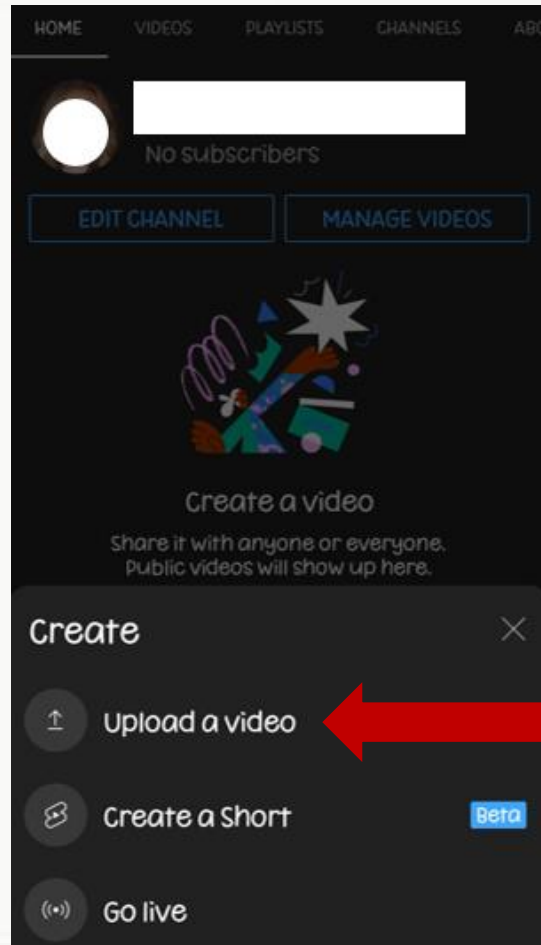




Next, click “Your channel” from the menu



Then, click “Create”

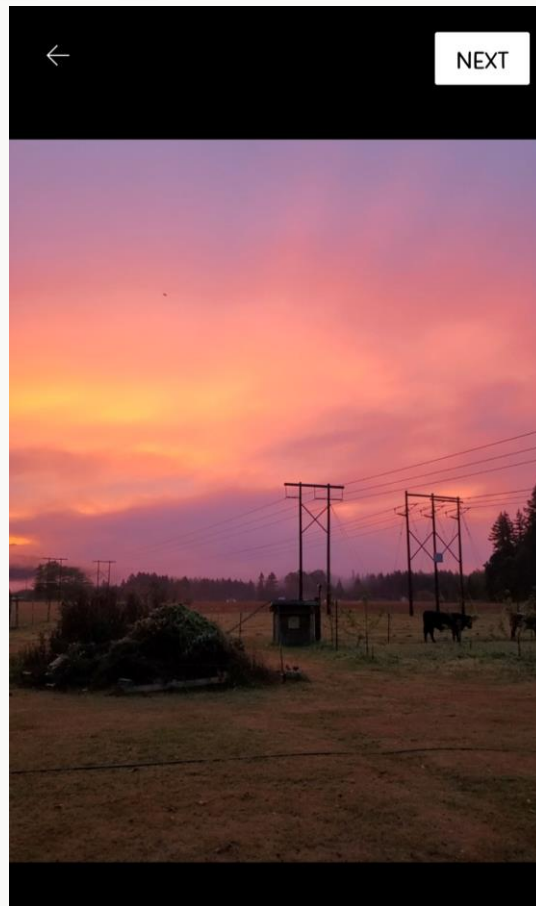


Then click “Upload a video”

You will then be prompted to select a file from your device's gallery to upload.


Make sure you tap on your Wax Museum Biography video file to upload it.

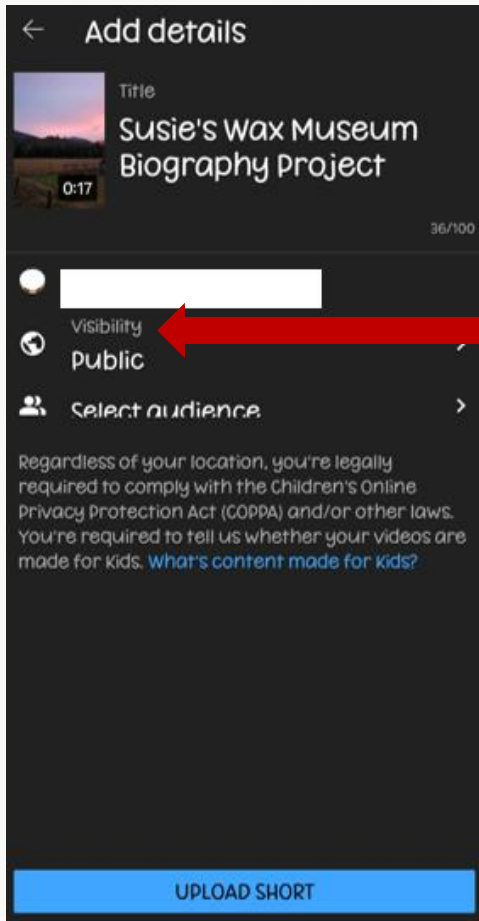

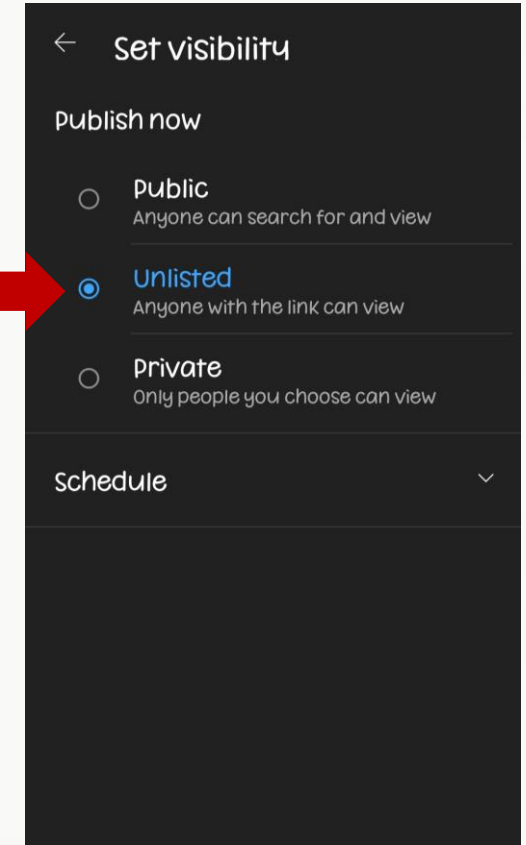

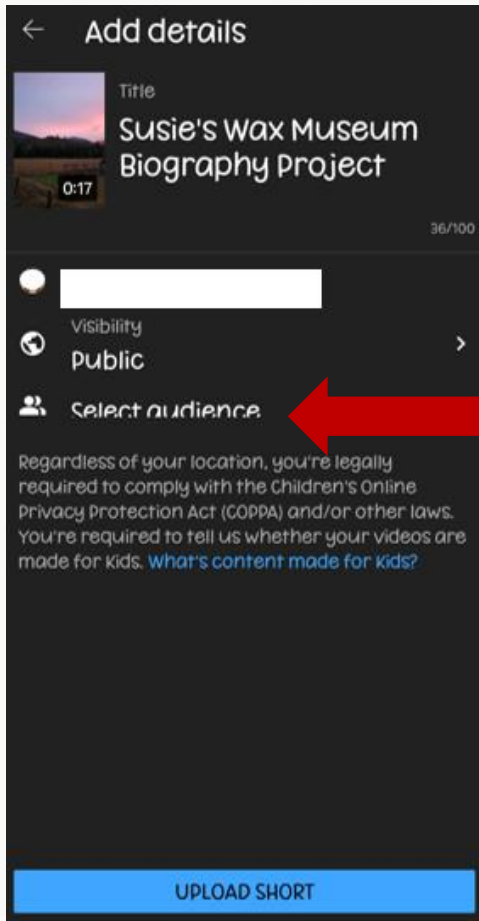


Then click

“Unlisted”

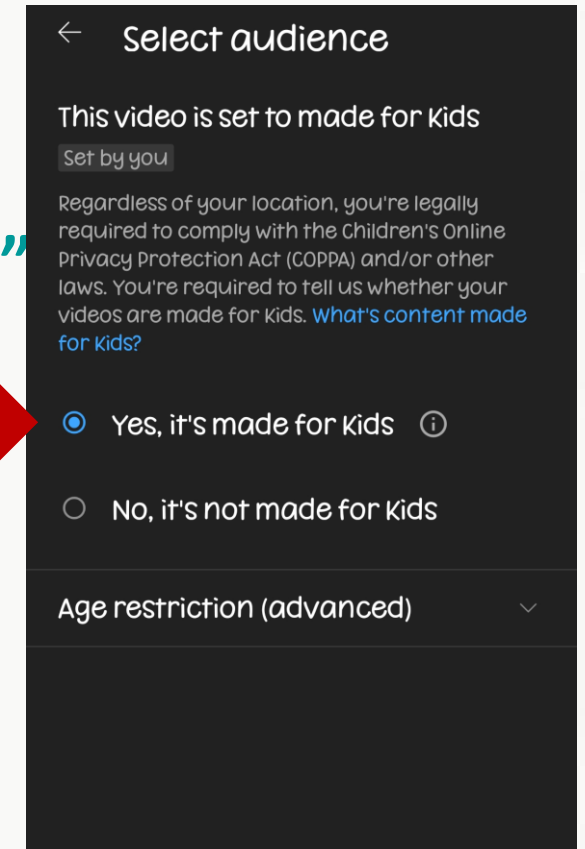

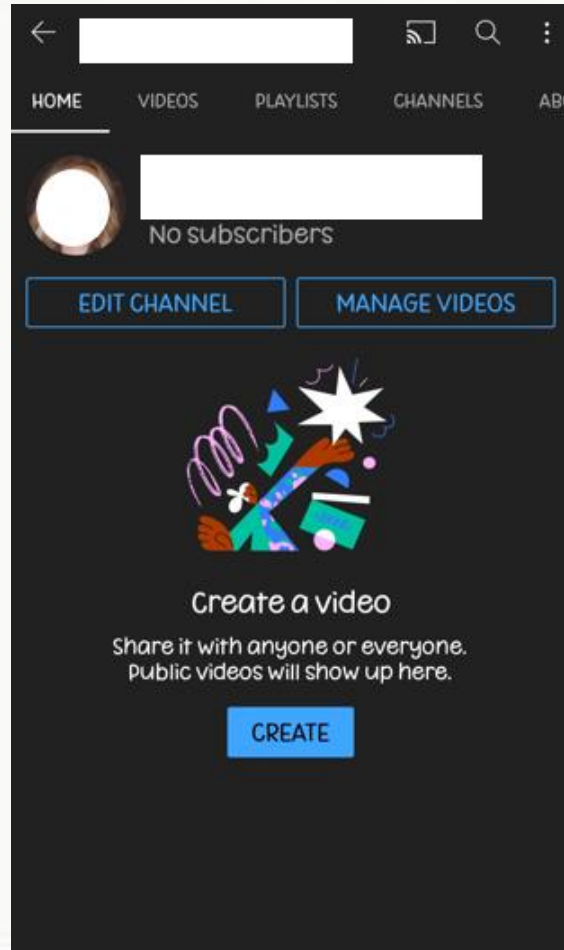


Then click
“Select audience”

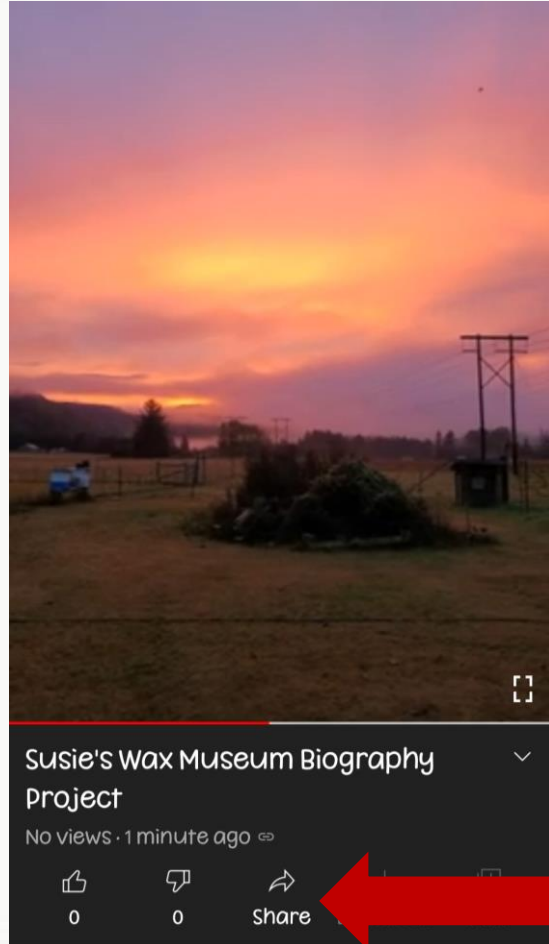
And select “Yes,

presentation.

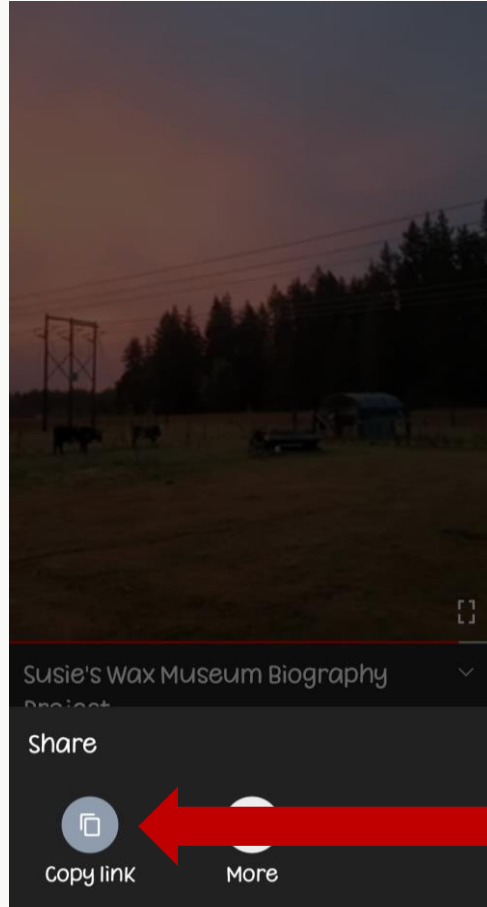




When your video is done uploading, click “Manage Videos”. Then tap on your video to open it




Click "Share"
